How to Start Work In Real Estate

To start work in the NSW real estate industry as an Assistant Agent, you must hold a Certificate of Registration with the NSW Fair Trading.

- Working under a Certificate of Registration allows you to work as an Assistant Agent in real estate sales, property management, stock and station. As an Assistant Agent you must be employed by a licence holder and supervised by a licensee in charge.
- To be eligible for a Certificate of Registration, you must:
 - Be at least 16 years old.
 - Be a fit and proper person to hold a Certificate of Registration.
 - Complete the required training course.
 - Not be a disqualified person.
- For any questions about eligibility in New South Wales real estate licensing, contact NSW Fair Trading on 13 32 20.
- Real Estate Licensing requirements differ in each state and territory. However, you may be able to apply for mutual recognition to transfer your qualification and work interstate if need be. Contact the real estate licensing body in your chosen state for more information.

Step 1 Certificate of Registration (Assistant Agent)

- > Work as an assistant agent in real estate, stock and station
- > Must be employed by a licence holder and supervised by a licensee in charge who holds a Class 1 Real Estate Agent Licence
- > Issued for a four-year term and not renewable
- > Within the four-year period, you must complete your qualifications and progress to a Class 2 Real Estate Agent Licence

Step 2 (Class 2) Real Estate Agent Licence

- > Act as an agent for a prospective purchaser, seller, landlord or tenant
- > Negotiate transactions (e.g. buying, selling, exchanging or leasing property)
- > Collect rent for a lease and provide property management services
- > Must have held a Certificate of Registration for at least 12 months and gained experience under the supervision of a licensee, completed work experience requirements, and completed the required upgrade qualification

Step 3 (Class 1) Real Estate Agent Licence

- > Authorised for all the same activities as a Class 2 licence holder, PLUS:
- > Act as a Licensee In Charge (LIC)
- > Work independently as a sole trader
- > If you are a LIC, open and authorise trust account transactions for the business
- > Must have held a Class 2 Real Estate Agent Licence for at least 2 years, completed work experience requirements, and completed the required upgrade qualifications

New South Wales Assistant Agent Course (Certificate of Registration)

The Assistant Agent course is for those wanting to start work in the real estate industry. Assistant Agent is an entry level position, to allow you to get the experience and knowledge needed to become a licensed agent.


